Gymnastics Foundations Trained & RiS Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May act as a coach or assistant coach under supervision (within reasonable proximity - within eye-sight) of a certified coach (minimum Gymnastics Foundations certified, Level 2 technical is highly recommended) • May NOT teach Level 2 NCCP skills or inverted skills with flight • Gymnastics Foundations coaches are required to follow the guidelines as per the relevant NCCP Gymnastics Foundations manual 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register as a recreational coach with GBC • WAG - Gymstart Level 1-2
Gymnastics Foundations Certified & RiS Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May supervise their own group • May act as a supervising coach to Pre-CIT or GF coach in training • May NOT teach Level 2 NCCP skills or inverted skills with flight (flipping) • TG: May only coach non-inversion elements • Gymnastics Foundations coaches are required to follow the guidelines as per the relevant NCCP Gymnastics Foundations manual 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register as a coach with GBC • All GFA Recreational / Educational classes • All GFA Public Access Programs (except cheerleading) • TG: Provincial C and D (non inversion routines only)
Gymnastics Foundations Certified & L2 Technical (No Theory or Practical) & RiS Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May supervise Gymnastics Foundations trained coaches and spot athletes performing Level 2 NCCP skills • May do skill assessment for participants who have previous gymnastics experience to determine if aerial inversions are allowed • May NOT spot or Teach Level 3 NCCP skills 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register as a coach with GBC • High School Programs Level 1-2 • WAG - CPP Level 1, Gymstart L 3-4 • MAG - Provincial Program Level 1-2 • TG - All categories • Able to supervise cheerleading programs (meeting GBC program guidelines - see GFA section)
L2 Certified & RiS Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May NOT spot or teach Level 3 NCCP skills • MAG/WAG: Required to access field of play at GBC sanctioned events (including BC Champs and BC Games) and Westerns - applicable categories listed to the right • TG: Required to access field of play at Western Canada Cup, WAGS and national events 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register as a coach with GBC • High School Programs Level 3-5 • WAG - CPP Level 2-5, Gymstart Level 5, Pre-Novice • MAG - ALL GCG program categories • TG - All categories
L2 Certified & L3 Technical (No Practical) & RiS Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May coach and spot any gymnastics skill 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register as a coach with GBC
L3 Certified & RiS Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May coach and spot any gymnastics skill • NCCP Level 3 certification required to coach MAG/WAG National and HP categories • MAG/WAG: Required to access field of play at GBC sanctioned events for Ntl & HP categories (excluding WAG Pre-Novice) and national events including Elite Canada & Canadian Championships • TG: Required to access field of play at World's and international events 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register as a coach with GBC • WAG - All Categories • MAG - All Categories • TG - All categories
